

232-4(B) Prohibitions; motorboats and vehicles; highways and roadways.

- (1) Except as provided in Subsection **D**, no person may:
 - (a) Place, possess or transport a firearm, bow or crossbow in or on a motorboat with the motor running, unless the firearm is unloaded, or a handgun, or unless the bow does not have an arrow nocked or the crossbow is not cocked or is unloaded.
 - (b) Place, possess or transport a firearm, bow or crossbow in or on a vehicle, unless the firearm is unloaded, or a handgun, or unless the bow does not have an arrow nocked or the crossbow is not cocked or is unloaded.
 - (C) Load a firearm, other than a handgun, or discharge a firearm or shoot a bolt or an arrow from a bow or crossbow in or from a vehicle.
 - (D) Load a firearm, other than a handgun, or discharge a firearm or shoot a bolt or an arrow from a bow or crossbow from or across a highway or within 50 feet from the center of a roadway.
